Students Experience Spark Challenge



In mid-November, South High School students in Bradley Krauz's Anatomy & Physiology class participated in Northwell Health's Spark Challenge. Spark Challenge is an outreach program designed to educate students about the variety of careers available in the health profession. Students visited the Center for Innovation and Learning where they were given a hands-on tour of the 22-bed simulated hospital floor. During this experience, they had the opportunity to work with interactive mannequins and simulated patients. Both are used to train a variety of staff. Improvement scientists and organizational-development specialists led students through various experiences during the visit. Students also visited the Division for General Internal Medicine where they had the opportunity to meet doctors, nurses, office managers, and other staff as they learned about the various professional opportunities that exist within a primary-care center.
